Policy Statement

- We recognize the responsibilities we have to our employees, customers, suppliers, and the wider communities in which we live and work as well as the environment as a whole. We are committed to responsible procurement of paper for our print activities including complying with the corresponding FSC™ (Forest Stewardship Council) Standards FSC™ -STD-40-004 (for Chain of Custody Certification), our self-declaration regarding FSC-POL-01-004 (Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC™) and FSC™ core labour requirements.
- FPIF shall not knowingly be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities.
 - Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products
 - Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations
 - Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations
 - Introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations
- FPIF understands FSC™'s standard and explicitly agrees currently and in the future not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities.
 - Not hire child labour (anyone under 18 years of age)
 - Eliminate all forms of forced and compulsory labour
 - Ensure that there is no discrimination in employment and occupation
 - Respect freedom of association and the effective right to collective bargaining. In addition, this Policy Statement shall be:
 - Reviewed at least annually
 - Communicated to all stakeholders and interested parties through our website
